

MISTAKES TO AVOID AS A MUSIC MINISTER

Mistakes to avoid as a Chorister or Music Minister

1) Avoid lateness to a rehearsal, church service or a ministration:

There is no commandment in the Bible that says, "Thou shall not be late" but there are damages that tardiness can cause to a worship team or ministration if not checked.

Take a look at these insightful scriptures:

I. 1 Samuel 16:7 "For the Lord does not see as a man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart"

II. 1 Corinthians 13:5 "Love is not rude"

III. Colossians 3:23-24 "And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ." Thus, as a psalmist, our service is unto the Lord and not unto men, in that case our conduct and preparation matters, you don't get to a rehearsal, job-place or meeting late and claim to love the brethren. It is simply a sign of disrespect. If indeed you expect a reward from the Lord, why then is your service time questionable?

The following are the damages created by lateness or tardiness:

I. Lateness depicts rudeness: Perpetual lateness to a rehearsal, service or ministration is a reflection of the program. This, to a large extent, would determine how the people would receive your ministry.

II. Lateness leads to loss of time and energy: When you as a minister, are late to a program, you struggle and

expend your energy in the wrong direction. If it is a rehearsal, the rehearsal drags as distraction and mediocrity sets in.

III. Lateness leads to lack of focus and futile efforts: Have you noticed that if you as a minister are well prepared for a ministration, arriving late at a program destabilizes you emotionally and psychologically as things go wrong when your instrumentalist and technical crew are not in alliance with your presentation modes? You struggle spiritually to settle into service and to grasp the movement of the Holy Spirit for that meeting, so you wander and end up in the flesh

entertaining the people. Worse still, your technical crew might mess up your presentation.

Promptness is an ethical, respectful and honorable virtue that every minister needs to build a strong and stable ministry that can stand the test of time.

SIX IMPORTANT LEGAL TRENDS TO WATCH OUT FOR IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF REGISTERED FAITH-BASED ORGANISATIONS (CHRISTIAN MINISTRIES) IN NIGERIA Part 1

A faith-based organization (FBO) is an organization (church, ministry, school, business) whose values are based on faith and or beliefs or which has a mission based on social values of a particular faith and which most often draws its activists (leaders, staff, volunteers) from a particular faith group. The legal milieu of the administration of registered FBOs in Nigeria is really witnessing some fundamental shifts. Indeed, the paradigm has shifted. It is rather surprising how a great number of those put in charge of administering religious organizations have chosen, either ignorantly or deliberately, to play the proverbial ostrich game of seeking false security by an illusory burying of the head in the sand while exposing the backside.

For many such religious organizations particularly Christian ministries, there is a tendency to assume a false sense of security and impunity simply because the organization is a religious body hence the organization can be excused by law or there would be some immunity from any prosecution whatsoever. The sad truth is that it is no longer business as usual and to that extent, many FBOs would likely find out too late that enough diligence was not engaged in the course of the discharge of their engagements. Therefore, this article is aimed at sensitizing ministries to the need to pay more attention to the following legal issues in the course of their operations;

1. Legal Compliance (Romans 13:1-6)

Compliance with the law and not defiance is fundamental for FBOs

modelling integrity. Otherwise the consequences can be devastating, and this could involve embarrassment, premises closure, building embarrassment, premises closure, building demolition, possible imprisonment of FBOs' personnel, impositions of fines for liabilities of different nature e.tc.

Therefore, serious attention needs to be paid to the following amongst others;

- Incorporation procedure
- Rules relating to no income earning status of trustees
- Compliance with laid down rules in the constitution
- Annual returns
- Winding down of operations

It is advisable to comply with the law and not to merely rely on indulgences, waivers, political connections or your relationship with security forces. It is in your best interest to always remember that things, people and times can change suddenly, and you might be improperly exposed to legal liabilities or violations of law.

2. Corporate Governance (1 Peter 5:1-4)

Corporate Governance can be described as the system of rules, practices and processes by which a company or an organization is directed and controlled. It essentially involves the balancing of interests of the organization's many stakeholders such as founders, trustees, management, members, the community and the government.

It is an international issue. Nigeria is perhaps one of the very few countries that has a very lax corporate governance regulatory regime. Take for example the

Charity Commission in the United Kingdom and the Home Office and Inland Revenue Service (IRS) in the United States

• There were a lot of hues and cries from some sections of the Nigerian Church over an attempt by the Financial Reporting Council (FRC) an agency of government, to introduce a Corporate Governance Code for adoption by Non-for-Profit Organizations in Nigeria. This somewhat led to the suspension of the code and the change of headship of the agency. However, the truth is that despite this outcry against the introduction of Code of Corporate Governance, there is a need to be guided because the wind has not totally blown over. A more clinical corporate governance code is in the offing and this time any resistance may not be countenanced by the Government and may as well elicit a negative backlash from the public against the church for resisting attempts to get them organized.





DR. HOPE
DAVID



1. Can we meet you sir/madam?

I am Dr. Hope David, a gospel artiste, people know me as Hope Davis from the beginning. People were actually the ones who changed The African Christian fellowship in 1993, gave me an award (a plaque) and wrote Davis as Americans are used to having Davis as family name and that's how the name came about. I am married to Pastor Michael David, the resident Pastor in Jubilee Christian Church Intl. I have two boys named Sammie and King.

2. How/when did you start ministry?

Professionally, I started music ministry 40 years ago. I used to be in groups back in school, but the turnaround was in 1982 when I went to do my gospel training in Benin city and joined the Bobby Idahosa choir called 'The Redeemed Voices'. met through a lady mentor that was when I knew I was going to be a gospel artiste.

3. How many albums have you done and what are your popular songs?

I have up to six to seven albums, my popular song was "Praise thy Lord, Halle, Halle Alleluia". I recently did the music video "Amazing God" during the Fusion 2019 concert.

4. What inspires you to write songs?

The Holy Spirit brings the melody; it can be when you are washing plates, driving, listening to a message or during praise and worship.

5. How do you manage your family and ministry?

You just need to know how to pull back and when you need to pull back. If you dedicate 15 minutes to something, like talking to a friend or any other meeting, pull out when you have to, attend to the spiritual and family matters, prioritize the agenda for your day, and schedule your time so your people will not mess up your time.

6. Who is your role model?

Jesus Christ is my role model but if we are looking at music – ministries that influence me, I will say Shirley Caesar, Hezekiah Walker.

7. What is your definition of a true worshipper?

The Bible says those that worship him in Spirit and in truth – that is, God is seeking those that worship Him in truth and in Spirit. You should worship God in truth and Spirit, while we sing in worship, we must be in the spirit, we must not manifest in the flesh.

8. Do you have any piece of advice for upcoming ministers?

Stay at what you are doing, many people have surprised us just because they stay at what they are doing. Nobody gave them a chance but with years and years, they keep doing it. If you know God has given you a talent, even when men disapprove of it, don't worry, keep at it & be persistent and God's grace will come through.



MINISTER TIM GODFREY



1. Can we meet you sir?

Resp: My name is Min. Tim Godfrey.

2. How did you start ministry?

Resp: I have been doing music since I was a kid, from the children choir to teenage to couple's choir and then I started learning instruments. Music has been a part of me as a young growing child in church. I was born in church and grew up in church, so music has been my lifestyle so basically, I have been doing music since I was a kid.

3. How old is your ministry?

Resp: Professionally, I have been a music director going on 4 to 5 years but as an artiste for 14 to 15 years.

4. How did you manage your ministry challenges?

Resp: There are the regular ups and down and the cost of rehearsing, producing, recording is very expensive, and it was hard for people to appreciate what I was doing. It was quite tough, and Nigeria is a place where we have abundant talents so finding a space was difficult but with consistency, we were able to fight our way through. We started from totally zero – people not believing in you. People prefer successful musicians than upcoming artistes.

5. What is your most popular song?

Resp: It is "Season by Season", before now it was Agidigba. We also have a lot of songs like "Na You Be God" and "So Good" but the most current one is "Nara" which hit up to 5000 views on YouTube within a month.

6. How do you get your songs/what inspires you to write songs?

Resp: I have been a songwriter for a long

time and composition of songs can be inspired from anything; while driving, eating, in showers, inspired by incidents I see... but of course God is our inspiration. God has channeled my own gift that anything can spark up inspiration for a song and I know when God is speaking, I know that it is Him.

7. Who is your role model?

Resp: It used to be Kirk, I have already involve in what God wants me to be, also the likes of John P. Kee and Kurt Carr. I had many role models, but Kirk had more influence when growing up.

8. How do you manage your family life and ministry life?

Resp: It is quite tough, and there's nothing anybody can do about that. It just the family to be able to understand and when I am at home, I try to be available as much I can to my family, but apart from that, they understand. I mean this period is always very busy for us – even when I get back to Nigeria, I spend one day at home and I am off again, it just happens all the time which they understand.

9. Are you married?

Resp: I am not married but it is by God's grace that I manage to be careful, I pray when I have to and flee when I have to. 10. What's your definition of a true worshipper? Resp: the term is relative. Worship is "sacrifice", the first time worship was mentioned in the Bible was between Abram and Isaac when Isaac asked, "where are we

going to?" and Abram answered, "we are going to "worship". So, the first literal meaning is "sacrifice" which I stand with, though things have changed, so everything we are giving God that demands sacrifice is worship. True Worship is how much sacrifice you are able to give God.

11. What's your advice for upcoming music ministers?

Response: Basically, to be consistent, be original, get something new and keep doing it. Never give up knowing what God has called you to do and doing it to bless people; not only for the money. Stay around your calling, be original and be the best and fight through it. In summary, Originality and Consistency is the key!

of a female backside with its sexual parts.



MINISTER OLUWAYEMISI-DUNMOYE



Interview questions for Minister Oluyemisi Dunmoye.

1. Can we meet you Ma?

My name is Minister Oluyemisi-Dunmoye, a woman of God, a wife and a mother who has been called to prayer ministry, I am a woman-empowering minister and also a youth lover.

2. When did you start ministry?

Officially, I started Dominion Power Ministry 2 years ago but have been in the ministry for more than 22 years, working with different churches and with different pastors.

3. How did you manage your ministry challenges?

There are so many challenges, and most of the time, it is gender role conflicts. When your leader is a male and you as a female that carries the power of God, you are going to be seen as a threat because of what you have. I noticed that a lot of male pastors are just teachers or theologically knowledgeable and most of them will do a lot to subdue you by not giving you roles that will bring many to the kingdom. They will you cast you aside which can be frustrating. Also quoting from the Bible that women should be quiet in the church, but you as a woman know you carry the power of God but can't do anything with it, it has been so challenging.

4. How do you manage your family life and ministry life?

For me, my home is my first assignment, if I am invited to minister or before I plan an

event, I have to ask my husband first. I give him the date, I also get his opinion and permission. Also, my kids are aware. I ensure I make meals for my family before leaving the house and after every ministration, I sit with them and discuss about the event. That way my family is not left out of my ministry. My husband is always joining me because I make him part of what I'm doing.

5. How does a minister live a healthy life?

I am guilty of that sometimes, some ministers believe that you have to fast for 100 days to see God, I don't believe in that because that way Ministers are aging so terribly. I don't believe that God is that hard, God is a gentle, loving God. We are allowing the old testament to affect us negatively as we are not maturing. Since I started my ministry, my eyes have been opened to many things in the Bible. To live a healthy life, we have to balance it by fasting and also eating good food and taking care of yourself. Not just fasting alone, God has not called us to slavery but gave us the right to call him Abba Father.

6. What's your definition of a true worshipper?

A true worshipper to me is someone that has given their life to God and can't do anything

without God; cannot move, breathe, eat without God. If you are a true worshipper, you admire the person that you worship. If you are a true worshipper you will surrender everything (marriage, home, intellect, degree) to God. A true worshipper gives in "totally to God".

7. What's your definition of a successful ministry?

A successful ministry in the world is when you build a big building but to me it's the number of souls that has been won for the kingdom, how many widows you have helped and how many children you have helped send to school, how many lives you can proclaim to have touched. Not the one you say but what people can testify to. That is what I see as a successful ministry. Jesus Christ's ministry is still talked about because of the souls He was able to touch when He was alive, so He's apostles.

Set-A: Interview for Rev. Victoria Aggrey

1. Can we meet you ma?

My name is Rev. Victoria Aggrey-Creppy. I am a co-pastor with my husband, Bishop George Creppy. We pastor Grace Family International Churches and our headquarter is in Lawrenceville Georgia. We started in New York and have a branch in Accra, Ghana in Africa. I have been married to my husband for 17 years and I am a mother of three children.

2. How/when did you start ministry?

My husband and I were pastoring one of the churches in International Central Gospel Church, we got married. I was living in England then, so we went back to Ghana and then moved to the State in Bronx New York where we opened the church that was also known as Revival Chapel. The church in Georgia was formerly known as Grace Chapel and then we changed it to Grace Family International Church because God spoke to us to focus on the family. We have been in Georgia for ten years now.

3. You mention that your ministry is focused on the family, why do you focus on the family?

It was a direction from God as every ministry has what God directs them to do and that is what makes the church of God and the Kingdom of God unique. Our mandate is to take care of the family because when you take care of the family, the society becomes good and the kingdom stands.

4. How did you manage your ministry challenges?

I think that once our focus is on God, we get strength from Him. There is no

challenge that is bigger than God. So, in everything God allows my way, I ask myself, what I can learn from it? Nothing brings me down. Even if it brings me down, God brings me back up, so I don't see challenges as bringing me down but as a learning platform to learn from and I trust God for great things. I also I manage it with the grace of God and help of God.

5. How were you able to manage the family and ministry?

Personally, God comes first, then my family second and the ministry God has given me as a church. Some of the mistakes we make as ministers is that we try to put the ministry first before family. God is responsible for the church as He died for the church, I am just a caretaker but my family is what God has given me so that is my responsibility. I must make sure they are good and that they love what God has given us and we are working together. I always point and direct my children to God.

6. What is your definition of a true worshipper?

I am a worshipper, worship has given me everything I have. It has to do with the attitude i.e. how you handle yourself in the presence of God. Worship is the priority we put on God and as Christians we should understand the depth of worship. We are created to worship God.

7. What's your definition of a successful ministry?

A successful ministry is an impactful ministry, most ministries are not impacting life but are a social gathering. It is not the size of the crowd or the money we have in our account, it depends on the lives we are

changing and also bringing people to Christ. It is all about soul winning for God.

8. Is there anything you want people to know about your ministry?

Apart from the church, I am the C.E.O. of The Hands of Grace Ministry and "Operation Others" a non-profit organization that takes care of orphans, widows, people in need and supports people in schools. I go to Jamaica for that, it's very active in Africa, in USA. Every three months we feed the homeless and provide blankets also. For Hands of Grace Ministry, I organize programs to promote things that will help the orphans and I give to the school. For Operation Others, we help young girls in Africa by providing sanitary pads, uniforms, books. I have a book written by me called "Discovery of Grace" and I have another book on 'Worship' coming soon.



The Beauty of Worship

(Part 1)

In this article, let's explore the biblical definition of WORSHIP to understand its beautiful purpose in our lives!

Apostle Paul described true worship perfectly in Romans 12:1-2 "I urge you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of GOD to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to GOD which is your spiritual service of worship. And do not be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable, or well pleasing and perfect."

This passage contains all the elements of true worship. First, there is the motivation to worship: "the mercies of GOD." GOD'S mercies are everything He has given us that we don't deserve: eternal love, eternal grace, the Holy Spirit, everlasting peace, eternal joy, saving faith, comfort, strength, wisdom, hope, patience, kindness, honor, glory, righteousness, security, eternal life, forgiveness, reconciliation, justification, sanctification, freedom, intercession and much more. The knowledge and understanding of these incredible gifts motivate us to pour forth praise and thanksgiving—in other words, worship!

Also in the passage is a description of the manner of our worship: "present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice."

Presenting our bodies means giving to God all of ourselves. The reference to our bodies here means all our human faculties, all our humanness—our hearts, minds, hands, thoughts, attitudes—are to be presented to GOD. In other words, we are to give up control of these things and turn them over to Him, just as a literal sacrifice was given totally to GOD on the altar. But how? Again, the passage is clear: "by the renewing of your mind." We renew our minds daily by cleansing them of the world's "wisdom" and replacing it with true wisdom that comes from GOD. We worship Him with our renewed and cleansed minds, not with our emotions. Emotions are wonderful things, but unless they are shaped by a mind saturated in Truth, they can be destructive, out-of-control forces. Where the mind goes, the will follows, and so do the emotions. 1 Corinthians 2:16 tells us that we have "the mind of CHRIST," not the emotions of CHRIST.

There is only one way to renew our minds, and that is by the Word of GOD. It is the truth, the knowledge of the Word of GOD, which is to say the knowledge of the mercies of GOD, and we're back where we began. To know the truth, to believe the truth, to hold convictions about the truth, and to love the truth will naturally result in true spiritual worship. It is conviction followed by affection, affection that is a response to truth, not to any external stimulation, including music. Music as such has nothing to do with worship. Music can't produce worship,

although it certainly can produce emotion. Music is not the origin of worship, but music can be the expression of worship. Do not look to music only to induce your worship; look to music as simply an expression of that which is induced by a heart that is engulfed by the mercies of GOD, and obedient to His commands.

True worship is GOD-centered worship. It was created to Glorify JESUS CHRIST our savior and to enhance our relationship Him... (To be continued in the fall edition)
